Palliative care, also known as advanced illness care, is patient-centered medical care for anyone facing a serious illness. The goal is to improve your quality of life by focusing on relief from the symptoms and stress of your illness. Our team accomplishes this goal through expert symptom management, disease education, goal assessment to guide your plan of care, and connection with community resources, based on your psychosocial needs.

No. The palliative care team provides an extra layer of support and works in partnership with your primary doctor.

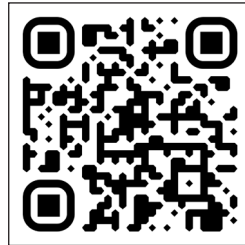
CAN I CONTINUE TO SEEK THE TREATMENT OPTIONS FOR MY ILLNESS?

By working with you to define your personal goals and needs, our team will create an individualized care plan to help improve the quality of life for you and your family.

Your Care Team Will Provide:

- Virtual, community clinic, or in-home Nurse Practitioner and Physician visits
- Virtual, community clinic, or in-home Palliative Care Social Work visits
- Virtual/telephone nurse care coordination and medication management
- 24/7 telephone access to providers for palliative care needs
- Medication management for disturbing symptoms
- Recommendations to address your symptoms and decrease distress
- Better understanding of your disease and prognosis
- Assistance with planning for your future healthcare needs, including completion of advance directives
- Coordination with your existing healthcare providers to ensure your care aligns with your treatment goals
- Expert guidance from our palliative care team members on improving symptoms and enhancing your quality of life

What You Can Expect

Palliative care is intended to optimize your quality of life. Through close and ongoing communication with your care team, you can expect recommendations to lessen the effects of symptoms such as pain, shortness of breath, fatigue, constipation, nausea, loss of appetite and difficulty sleeping.
